FOOD PRESERVATION

Adult Superintendent-Loraine Faulkner

- 1. All canned products must be in standard clean glass (not sticky) jars (no mayonnaise jars) to be judged. Ball, Kerr, Mason or other brand name must be imprinted on the sides of the jar. Only half pints, pints, and quarts will be accepted. Jars MUST have rings (no rust) on and MUST be sealed. Rings will be taken off each jar to view the fill. If the product touches the lid, it will be disqualified. If liquid does not cover the product, it will be disqualified. Vegetables, fruits, pickles, relish and sauces should be filled to ½" from top of jar; Jellies, jams and preserves should be filled to 1/4" from top of jar. If your jar does not meet this rule, it may be disqualified. Jelly should not show any pulp and when the jar is tipped to the side the jelly should break from the side of the jar. Jam should show pulp and preserves should show pieces of fruit. Any entry can be rejected if any of the above rules are not adhered to. Appearance will be the judges' last test. If there are two jars with all else equal, then it comes down to which one has the best appearance in the eyes of the judge. The Judge's decision is always final.
- 2. Labels will be furnished at the Extension Office before check-in for convenience of exhibitors or at Fair check-in. AGE AS OF JANUARY 1, 2015 MUST BE ON ALL YOUTH ENTRIES THROUGH 18 YEARS OF AGE.
